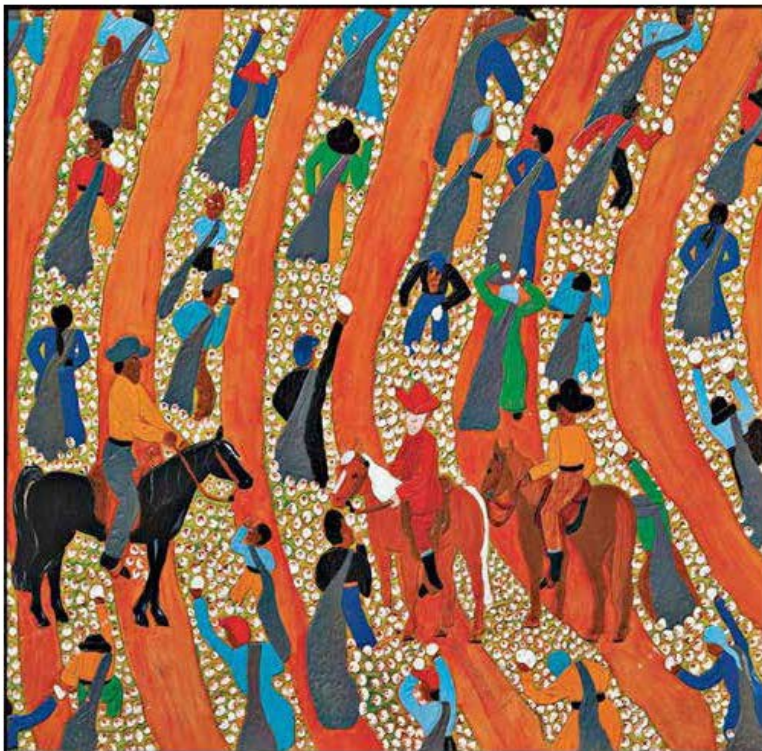

RACE AS A SOCIAL PRINCIPLE OF VISION AND DIVISION.

Inspired by Bachelard, Weber and Bourdieu, I sketch a framework for rethinking "race" as a principle of classification and stratification. I highlight its generic properties, common with other forms of human division, and its specific features, including the correspondence it establishes between culture and nature. Drawing on my book *RACIAL DOMINATION* (2024), I provide illustrations from around the world to flesh out the heuristic value of the framework.
